Effective August 1, 2008 all trash cans will need to have the building and unit number written on them.

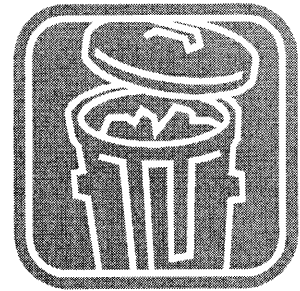
Any trash can that does not have a number on it will be removed from the property.
